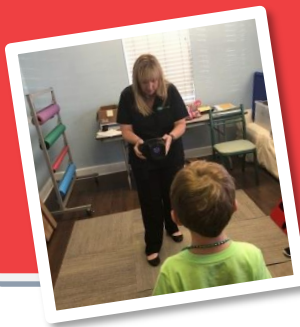


Our mission is to serve as the premier community resource for improving the vision health of First Coast children and adults through screening, referral, and education.

Vision Is Priceless was founded in 1996 to provide outreach vision services, including vision screenings, eye exams, and education for the community. Our programs are unduplicated in Northeast Florida, serving Baker, Clay, Duval, Nassau, and St. Johns Counties. Funding for the organization primarily comes through private donations, grants, and fundraising events.

Children's Program

- Annually screens more than 40,000 children 3 – 18 years old.
- Travels to nearly 500 schools and child care centers each year.
- Screens for early detection of vision issues, such as signs of eye diseases like amblyopia.



Adult Program

- Annually screens over 4,000 adults.
- Provides free vision screenings at social service agencies, medical clinics, and community health fairs.
- Distributes more than 1,600 pairs of free reading glasses each year.



Vision Care

- Provides access to vision care for underinsured and underserved individuals.
- Over 60 vision professionals donate their services each year.
- Last year, we provided 1,200 eye exams, 1,093 prescription glasses, and 267 specialty care services for those in need.



Did You Know?

- Based on health studies in Northeast Florida, the most delayed health exam is an eye exam.
- Studies confirm that 80% of knowledge and experience are acquired through visual applications.
- About 50% of all cases of blindness are preventable.
- One in four children has a vision issue significant enough to affect learning.
- Vision Is Priceless is the only organization providing these free, sight saving services in Northeast Florida.
